






Communication From School




Support From School




Staff Capacity




Parent Capacity




Parent Perceptions

- We put neutral for covid-19 because it's a delicate subject to which the school seems put in a rock in a hard place. Covid-19 protocols are old and outdated and not aligned with science. The masks have been on these kids for far too long. People who want and need to protect themselves have that ability with the vaccine and to mask themselves. Mask and testing needs to end now.
- I was not aware of any training for parents last year but it's a good idea for the future
- I find it unfortunate that this survey could not be conducted anonymously.

Ballard School has a history of challenges in defending under-represented members of our community. So far, the district has not taken up community requests

- The school should have solar panels and work on being more green. I think the internet needs a big upgrade.
- Really want to see the school staff get DEI training, and be more hands on about bullying /

students getting slightly traumatized by more aggressive kids. You can't tell a first grader to "go work it out amongst yourselves" if one child is much more dominant than the other.

- School needs DEI and bias training. Families who are BIPOC, LGBTQ, disabled, immigrant, ESL, low-income are not valued or integrated into the community. School lacks ADA compliance, ESL, and diversity training. Bullying of kids whose parents raise these issues is rampant and principal and teachers know and take no action.

- Significant lack of diversity at this school.

Or learning about POC this impacts children's understanding of differences and is detrimental when they attend middle school as biases and stereotypes already formed.

- This school could certainly benefit from a DEI program. With Ballard's lack of diversity within its staff and student body, many students and parents have a deficit understanding of people's differences, most especially pertaining to people of color, LBQTQ and students with special needs. As the school is predominantly white, this DEI program would only help with bias and stereotyping in all forms.

- Should be parents' choice on if their child has to wear a mask. Should not be enforced by staff.
