- I don't think that we have a drug or truancy problems here, on the choices of the survey said severe problems and doesn't give a good choice to select.
 - Teachers definitely need more support with discipline (it shouldn't be SO MUCH of the teacher's responsibility when there are specific Admin/Assigned Staff that can contribute.) SEL Content was promised to be integrated in our curriculum, but has yet to appear.
 - with the constant rise of covid cases, with teachers feeling burn out drastically and students who either are terrified of school or feel disrespected by teachers who treat them like children. it feels like school for all parties has become a drag and students aren't learning or getting anything out of the day.
 - I feel that our cares a lot for our students, but some times it forgets about the staff. We have put in practices and protocols to keep everyone safe, but they aren't always followed or are forgotten. Staff feels unsafe and some times unappreciated.
- Also, as far as providing many opportunities for students, I feel that our school can do a better job with providing more choices for our kids, when it comes to classes and career pathways. There's very few choices when it comes to pathways.
- Teachers are told their voice matters and that their input is valued and taken into consideration in school policy decision-making; however, this isn't always evidenced in school policies or actions.
