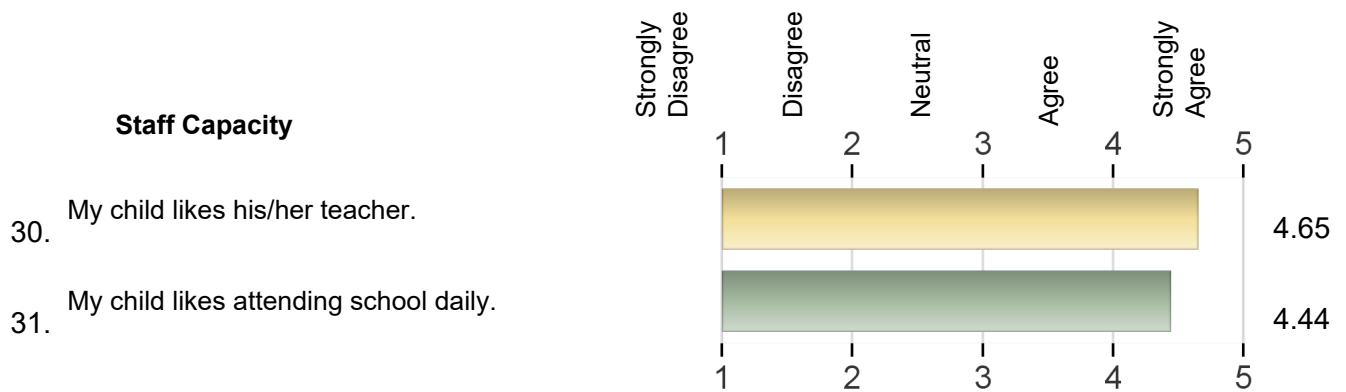
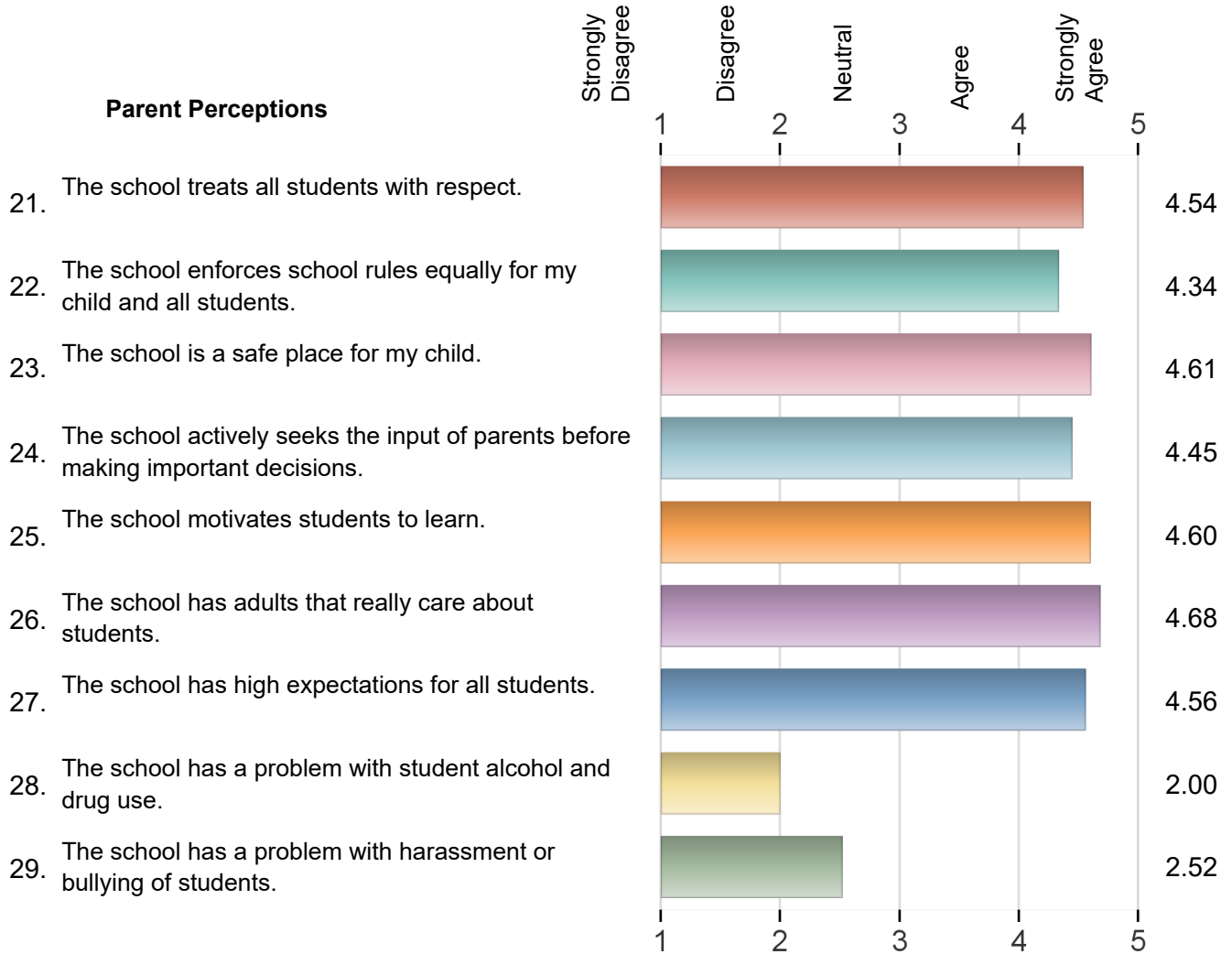


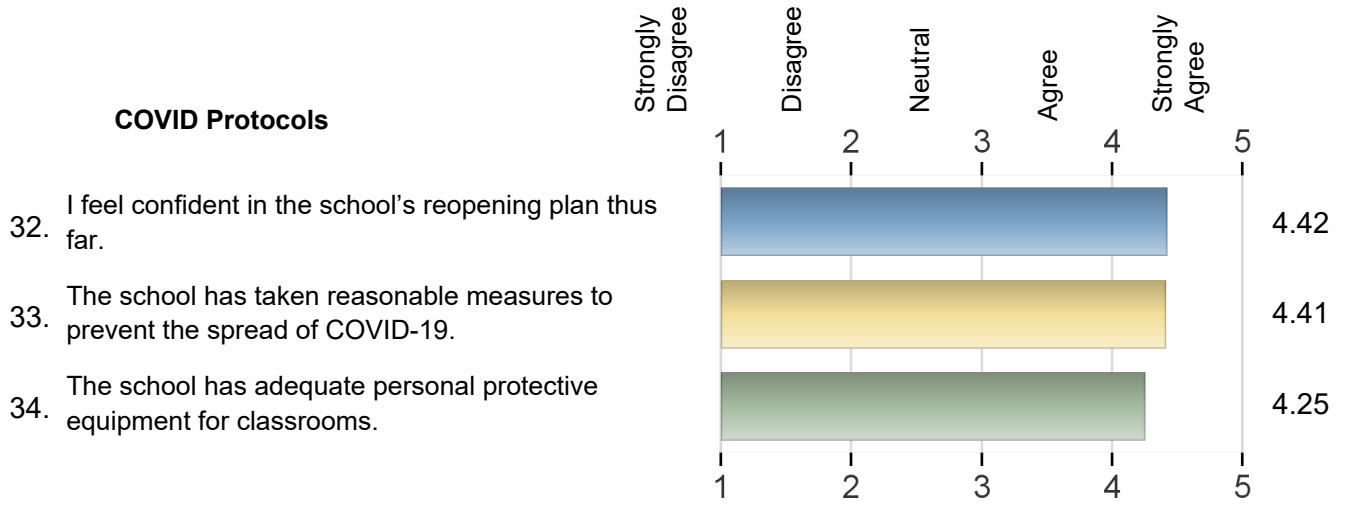
Staff Capacity

- I'd appreciate more communication regarding special education. Services I requested have not been followed up on in a timely manner.
- Feel need for more communication to parents from staff & teachers. More parent involvement.
- Restrooms often do not have soap. Racial Slurs and bullying has been rampant on the bus. Seems to be high turnover of teachers in my children's classrooms. Art/drama teacher rude to scholars, very repetitive in his teachings and is the most complained about teacher by scholars and parents.
- Discipline has become soft. In the past I feel the kids respected the rules more. I don't feel the kids this year take the rules seriously and/or have strong enough consequences.
- I wish it were easier to get help for students with high anxiety... My kid never sees the councilor after initial contact was made on their behalf
- I don't like the homeless population living at the P Street bus stop
- i do worry about safety at the school because i think it would be rather easy for someone to get on campus because it's an old school, so i will be excited for the new campus construction.
- The school sends out daily/weekly reminders of upcoming events and find that very helpful. I often feel that the teachers are not communicating enough. I like to know what the students learned or will learn for the week so I can reinforce the learning at home. I don't need to know how the teachers will present the subject matter; I like knowing what they're working on in class.
- I would like to see the maintenance /operations personnel attend focused/specific training/certification classes/ certifications
