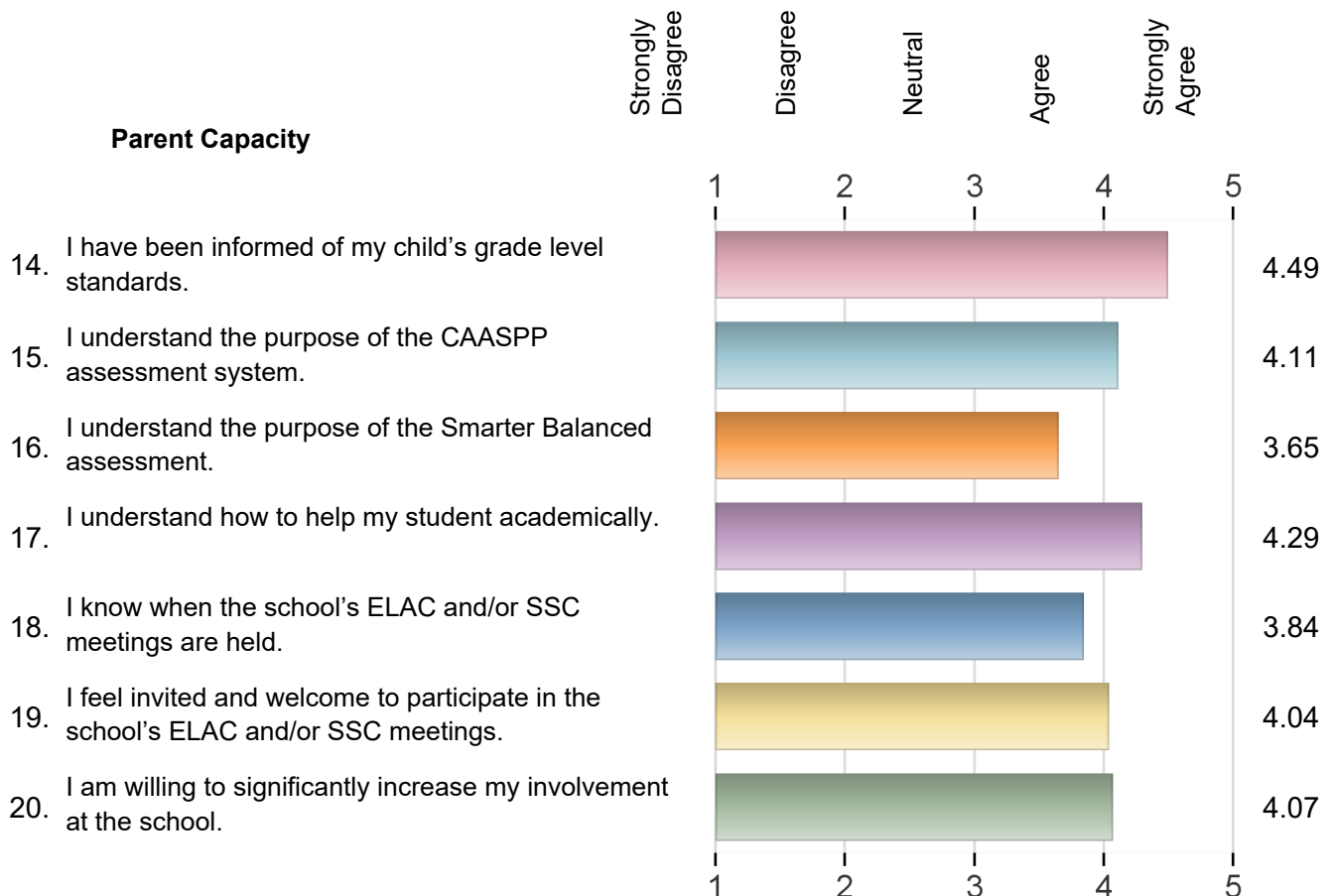

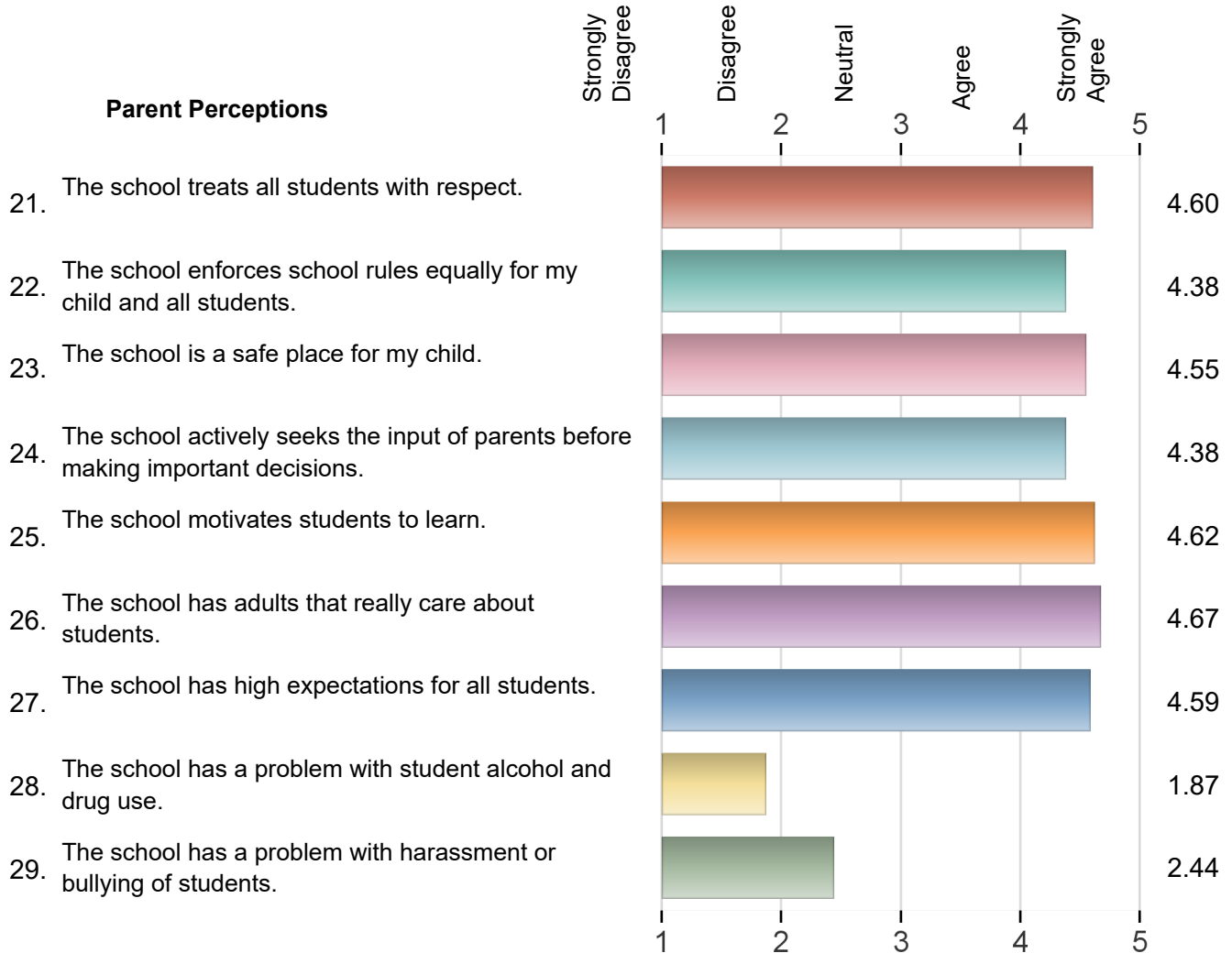

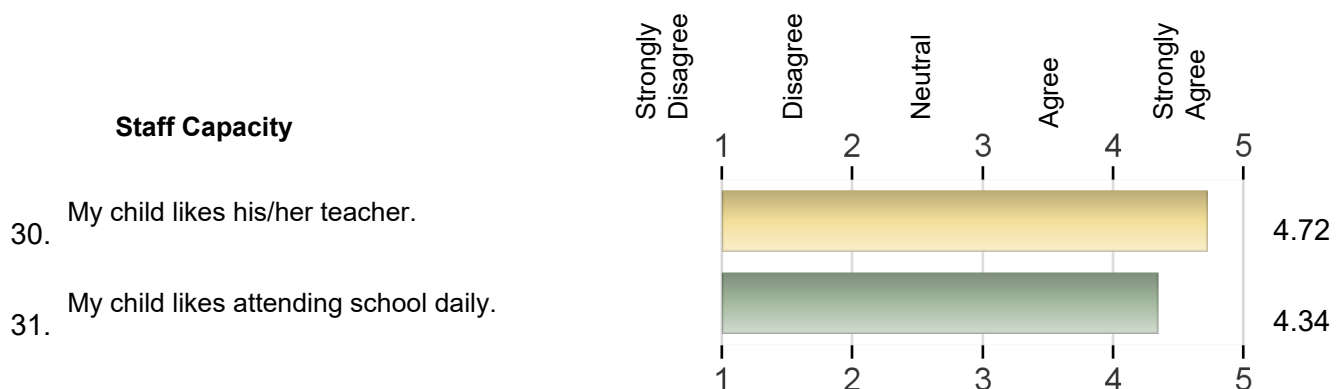

- Some teachers could improve on communication and providing more frequent updates.
- The way the dress codes were enforced this year was terrible. My kids get dress coded and changed yet I see other kids wearing pink leggings and sweats on regular dress days. A big complaint is how little time the kids get to eat lunch. And I'm always concerned about safety overall on campus.
- Substitute teachers are inappropriate and make harassing comments to kids when brought to administrative attention they deny allegations and twist to their own liking
- Refuse to let you meet with staff to discuss concerns
- Horrible principal with unprofessional behavior and lack of accountability
- I would like more communication about keeping my child on track and how I can work with them at home if they are falling behind. I feel like more frequent check ins with parents would be beneficial for my child, instead of waiting for the trimester meetings. Thank you for considering.
- Should be flexible policy for military families
- Vice Principal not as professional. Bus behavior is very bad (cursing, racial slurs) and rules are not enforced.
